



By Virtue of a Warrt from the Hon^{ble} Proprietaries bearing date the Tenth day of October Anno D^o/1738. I have Survey'd and laid out unto Henry Davis on a Branch of Codorus Creek in the County of Lancaster on the West Side Susquehanna river in right of ~~Mark Harvey~~ Philip Shute One hundred and thirty four acres of land with allowance of Six P. Cert Beginning at a Black Oak a corner of Joh. Deardolph's land thence North sixty degrees Westerly forty perches to a Black Oak thence North thirty Degrees Easterly One hundred and Sixty Pches. to a White Oak Thence South Sixty degrees Easterly One hundred and Sixty Perches to a white oak Thence South Thirty deg^s Westerly One hundred and fourteen perches to a white oak Thence North Eighty one Degrees Westerly one hundred and Twenty eight Pches. to the Place of Beginning
