



A draught of 147 a 142 perches of land with allowance of 6 per cent for Roads &c Situate in Decatur Township Mifflin County Penn^a Surveyed May 19th & 20th 1852 and March 2nd & 3rd 1853 in pursuance of a Warrant to Joseph Stump for 200 acres dated June 18th 1841. At the time of Survey is a dwelling house of about 20 by 24 feet of hewn logs on this land & Benjamin Speiglermoyer & his family residing in it & about 10 acres cleared & in fence
