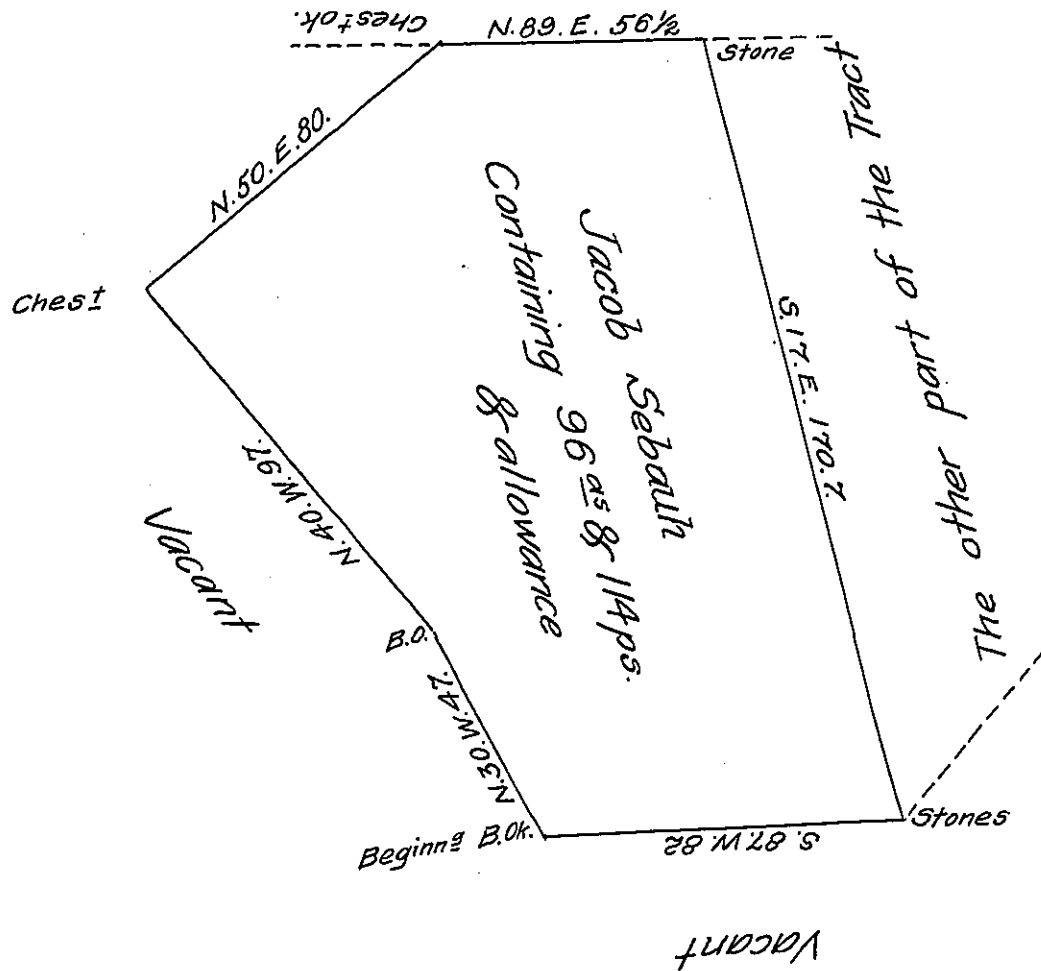


Jacob Walter
