



*Situate* in Codorus Township, York County, & Containing as above set forth 98 & 115 & allowance Being a part of a larger tract of 201 & 89 ps. & c. of land Surveyed by William Matthews late D.S. on the 13<sup>th</sup> of the 11<sup>th</sup> mo. 1766 in pursuance of a Warrant bearing date the 31<sup>st</sup> day of May 1762 granted to Jacob Sebaugh for 100<sup>a</sup>. Afterwards divided off from the said larger Tract. And now, after having been carefully examined Corrected & Calculated, it is, at the request of the present owner Henry Strickhouser, returned for Confirmation the 22<sup>d</sup> day of August Anno Domini 1809 per Jacob Spangler D.S.
