



Situate in Cummings Township County of Lycoming on the waters of the Second fork of Larrys Creek and bounded as above discribed. Surveyed to William B. Smith by virtue of his Warrant for 400 acres dated the 17<sup>th</sup> day of August 1830. Surveyed on the 25<sup>th</sup> day of October 1839. Containing four hundred acres and Ninety Six perches with allowance of Six per Cent. for Roads &c.
