



Situate on Sidling Hill creek in Dublin Townships Huntingdon & Bedford Counties (formerly Camberland) Surveyed under the direction of Rich<sup>d</sup> Tea late Deputy Surveyor the 1<sup>st</sup> day of May A.D. 1766. In pursuance of a Warrant dated the 24<sup>th</sup> day of February 1763. Rea Surveyed agreeable to the old lines and corrected the 21<sup>st</sup> day of April A.D. 1814.
