



Situate on the Turnpike road leading from Bedford to Pittsburg, on the Waters of Stoney Creek, Including an Improvement first begun 1st March 1803 whereon a family had resided & raised grain previous to the issuing of the warrant & have continued their actual residence thereon unabatedly until the time of making this Survey. — It is part of the former claim of Jessey Ringler's tract, & the Improvement of this & that also begun about the time aforesaid, & Surveyed the 23rd Day of May 1816. In pursuance of a Warrant Dated the 13th day of June 1815. Granted to George Stauffer.
