



A Draft of a tract of land situated in the township of Carroll and county of Washington. Containing two acres and forty perches and Allowance of six per cent for roads &c. It being a part of a larger tract of twenty four acres 152 perches and Allowance. originally surveyed in pursuance of a warrant granted to Thomas Scott. dated the 26<sup>th</sup> day of August 1823. Surveyed and divided from the residue of said tract on the twenty third day of November 1883 by J. M. Moumger Esq. late county Surveyor whose notes I have this Seventh day of April 1884 examined and approved (The residue of the tract, marked "A." is within the lines of Adam Wickerham Senr. tract warranted the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of March 1788).
