



Situate on one of the head branches of Quemahoning Creek on the dividing ridge between the waters of Quemahoning- and Coxes Creek now in Somerset Township Somerset County (late Quemahoning Township Bedford County. Including an Improvement begun the 1st day of October 1795. and Surveyed the 1st day of November 1795 by Alexander McClean Esquire then Deputy Surveyor. In pursuance of a Warrant dated the 26th day of April 1794. as appears by his Official Draught & Warrant remaining in my Office.

Examined, Certified & Returned the 16th day of February 1816 for Abraham Miller Esquire, present Owner in Right of John Shull.
