And the Other part thereof Marked letter B. Containing Seventy three acres \$ 121 pr. & all. Being a part of a Tract of Land, Surveyed March 4th 1809 in Pur--suance of a Warrant. Granted to Dorothy Stitts & David English Executors of Samuel Stitts, dated the 2d day of May 1796 both these Tracts are now situate in Washington Township, Westmoreland County.
