



A draught of two tracts of land situate in Decatur township Mifflin County containing together 235<sup>ac</sup> 67<sup>ps</sup> and the usual allowance of six per cent for roads &c. one is a part of a tract surveyed the 30<sup>th</sup> day of March 1774 in pursuance of Warrant to John Chaloner dated the 16<sup>th</sup> day of March 1773. The other is a tract of land surveyed the 29<sup>th</sup> day of March 1842 by John Shaw Esq. late D.S. Examined and corrected for William Snook the 19<sup>th</sup> day of March 1845 in pursuance of his warrant dated the 7<sup>th</sup> day of March 1845.
