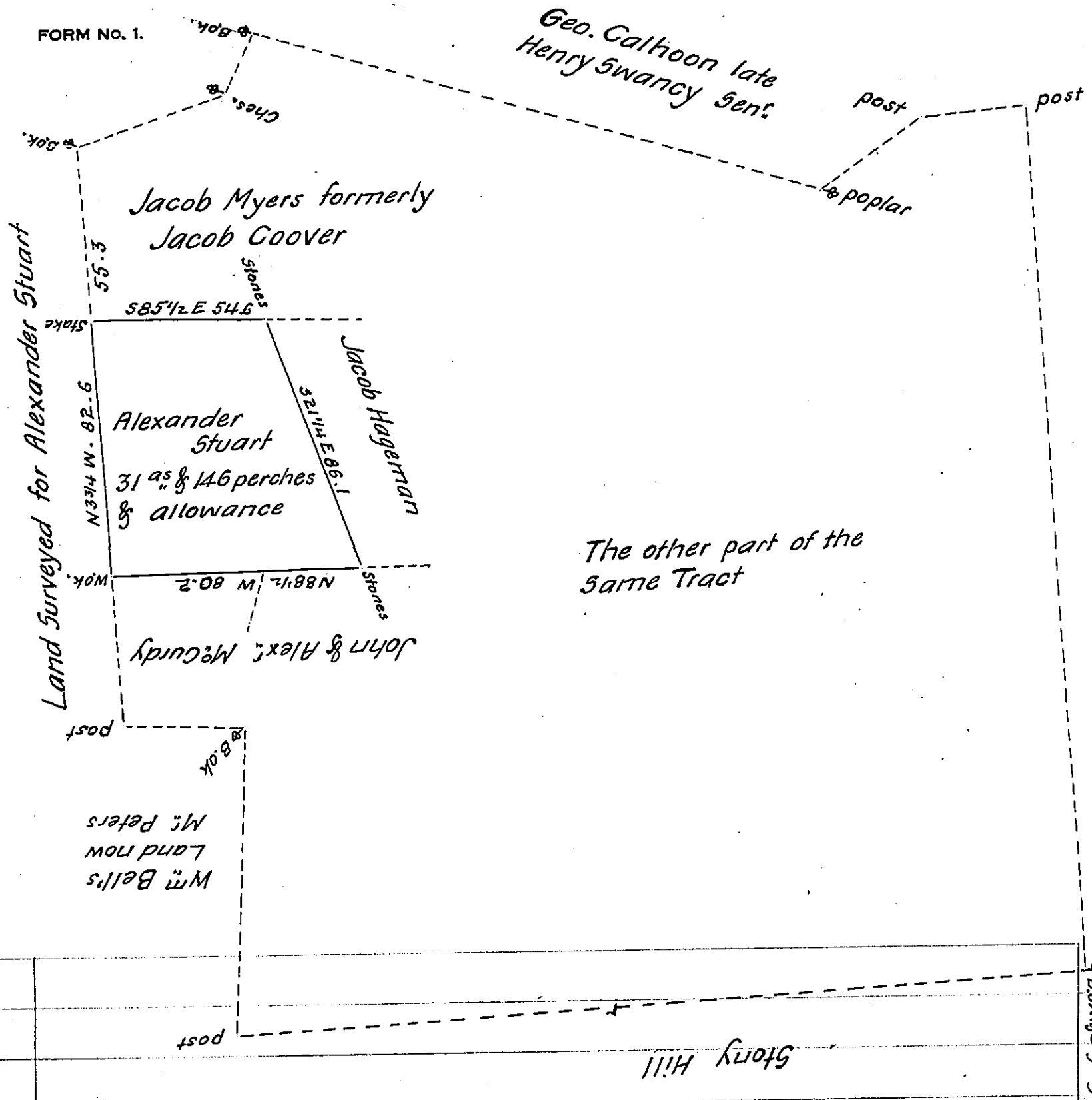

Situate in Managhan township in the County York Containing within the black lines thirty-one acres, one hundred and forty six perches & allowance. Being part of a larger Tract of Five hundred twenty-six acres and an half & allowance, which was Originally Surveyed on the 12<sup>th</sup> day of October 1751. by Geo. Stevenson late D.S. in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Alexander Stuart bearing date the 9<sup>th</sup> day of June 1750. Resurveyed and divided off from the said larger Tract of Land the 15<sup>th</sup> day of November 1845 at the instance of Jacob Hageman the present owner, who desires the same to be returned for Confirmation.
