



Situate in Windsor township in the County of York Containing as above set forth 16<sup>ac</sup> 137 perches and allowance, Surveyed the 12<sup>th</sup> day of June 1821. In pursuance of a warrant granted to Jacob Stavely and Frederick Flinchback for 18<sup>ac</sup> bearing date the 26<sup>th</sup> day of February 1821. The improvements on the above described land at the time of Surveying Consisted of About 10<sup>ac</sup> cleared land composed of parts of sundry fields but no buildings
