



A Draught of a Tract of Land in Mill Creek Township Erie County Surveyed July 7th 1824 for David McNear & Nicholas Staugh by Virtue of an Improvement & Settlement made there on for the use of the said David McNear Containing 261 Acres 74 Perches & allowance of Six Per Cent for Roads &c. Viz that part within the Black lines Containing 32 acres 84 perches is Claimed by the said Nicholas Staugh and the Remainder within the dotted lines Containing 228 Acres 150 perches with the usual allowance &c is claimed by the said David McNear the Improvement Contains about twenty Acres, Richard Gilleland a Tenant under David McNear was living on the land had a house on it and there was Rye oats &c Growing on the land when I Surveyed it
