



A Draught of a Tract of land called ——— Situate near the head waters  
of Wyalosing Creek adjoining land Granted to Dan<sup>l</sup> Rees in the County of Northumberland  
land containing three hundred and One Acres and three Quarters of an Acre  
besides the usual allowance of six P. Cent for Roads &<sup>ca</sup> Surveyed the fourteenth  
day of September 1776 for John Vicary. In pursuance of a Warrant dated the  
19<sup>th</sup> day of August 1774.
