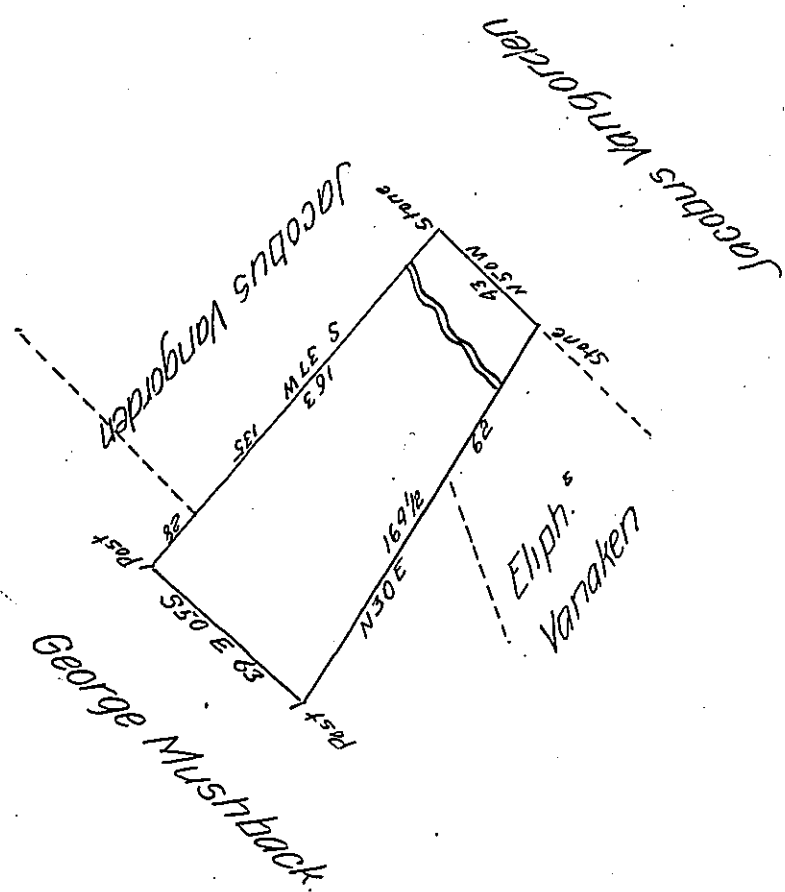

By Virtue of a Warrant dated the 10<sup>th</sup> January 1794 Surveyed the 7<sup>th</sup> September 1794 to Jacobus Vangorden the above described tract of land situate on Eliph<sup>s</sup> Vanaken's Mill Creek about half mile from Delaware River in the County of Northampton Containing fifty Acres one hundred and fifty perches and the allowance of Six P. Cent & c<sup>a</sup>.
