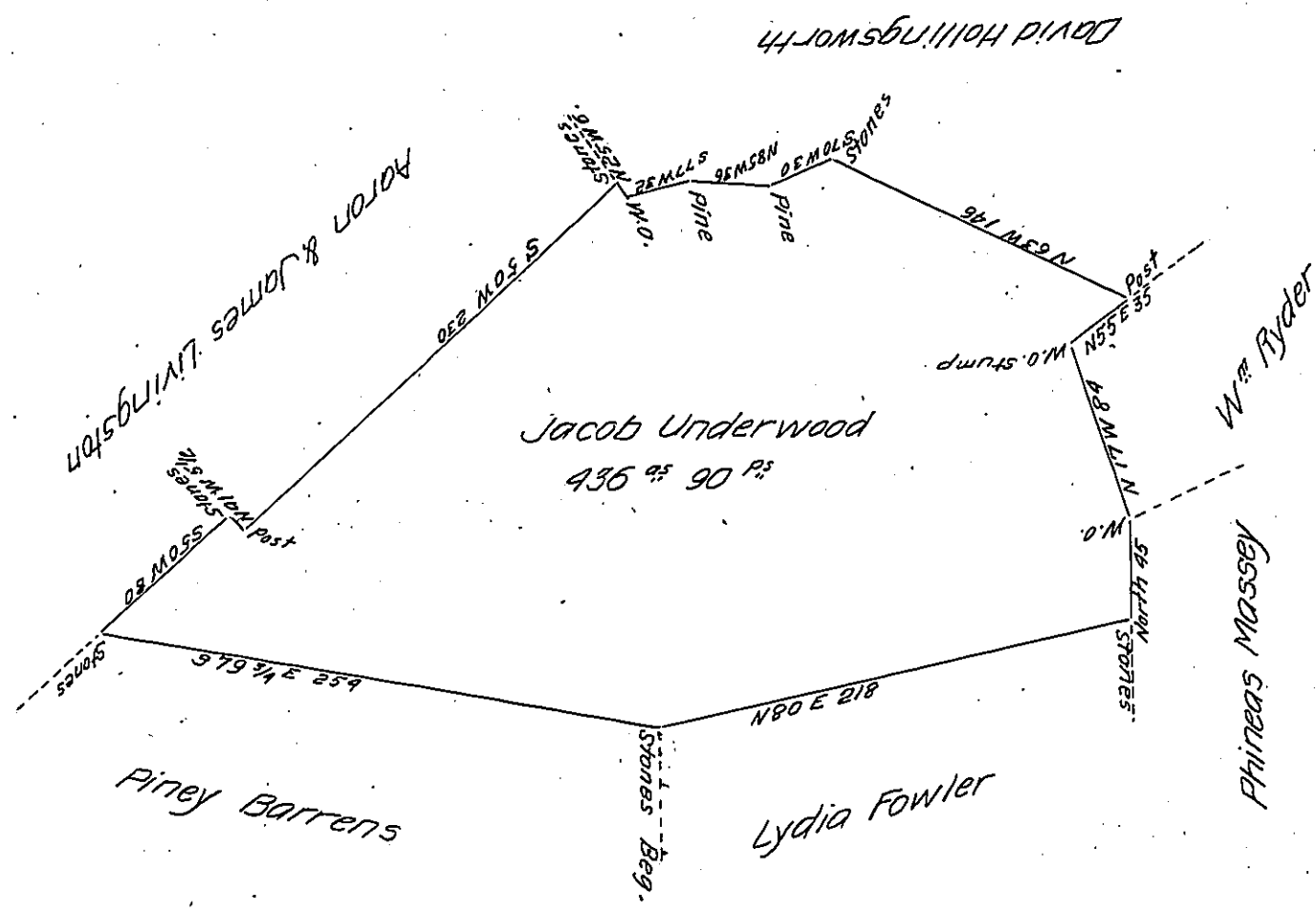


FORM NO 1.



The draught of a tract of Land situate in Half-moon Township Centre County Containing four hundred and thirty Six Acres, ninety perches and Allowance of Six per cent &c.⁹ Surveyed the 4th day of May 1814 for Jacob Underwood in pursuance of his warrant dated the 6th day of January 1814

At the time the above Survey ^{was made} Jacob Underwood and his family was residing on the premises, the improvement consists of a Cabin House & Stable with about three Acres of cleared land, which he Says was first improved by him on the 1st day of May 1810.
