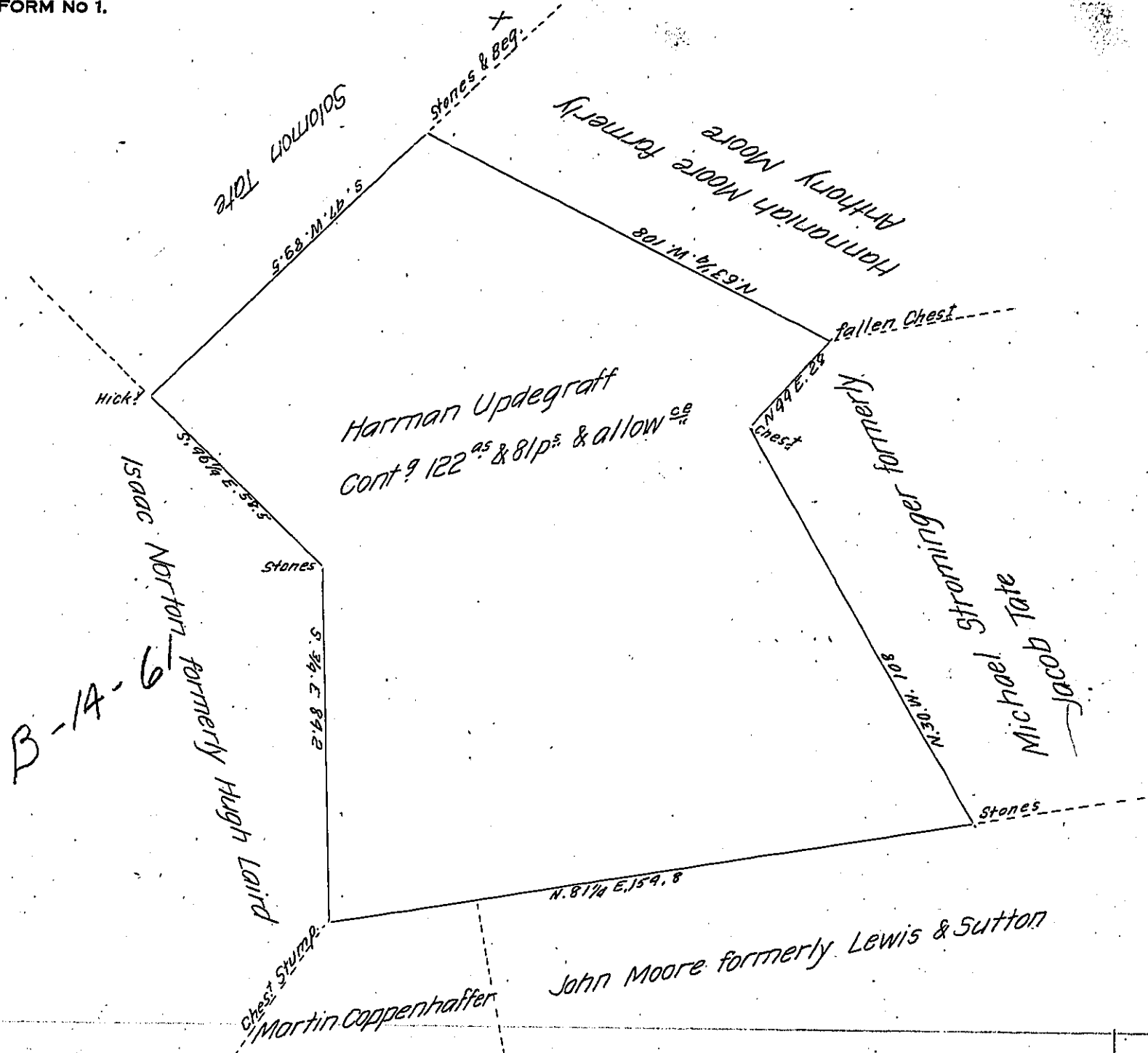

Surveyed on the 27<sup>th</sup> day of November A.D. 1811. In Pursuance of a Warrant for 100<sup>ac</sup> Granted to Harman Updegraff bearing date the first day of July A.D. 1789. And now at the request of the owner Michael Strominger the Same is Returned for Confirmation the 29<sup>th</sup> day of February A.D. 1812
