I have not suitable drafts of <sup>the</sup> two Sparks surveys or I would have maid out a draft with courses and distances, if the patent cannot be maid out without this send me copies of the two Sparks Surveys & I will connect & return, I have the John Martin- The 107a<sup>s</sup> & 122p<sup>s</sup> tract proports to have been Surveyed on a warrant granted to John Sparks dated 30<sup>th</sup> of June 1841. The 50a<sup>s</sup> Surveyed on a warrant to the same John Sparks dated the 17<sup>th</sup> of December 1830, and the John Martin tract was surveyed in pursuance of a warrant gra-ated in the name of John Martin for 50as. dated the 13<sup>th</sup> day of January 1790.
