 the One dated the 23<sup>d</sup> day of September 1762. & the Other the 5<sup>th</sup> day of  
 August 1763. Resurveyed and divided off from the said larger tract of Land  
 on the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of September A. D. 1812, for and at the request of John Hilde-  
 brand & Others, the present owners, who desired that the same should be  
 returned for Confirmation.
