



In pursuance of a Warrant dated Ap<sup>l</sup> 25<sup>th</sup> 1787, there was Survey'd for Henry Small the above described Tract of Land, containing two hundred and fourteen Acres and 48 perches, with an Allowance proportioned to Six  $\frac{7}{8}$  Cent. Situate part in Westmoreland and part in Allegheny County, on the Waters of Turtle Creek. Survey'd Ap<sup>l</sup> 12<sup>th</sup> 1792.
