



A Draught of an Island Situate in the river Susquehanna, Called Western Island about one hundred perches west of Williamsons Island, and Serenty perches west of Ceder and Water Willow Islands, and about eighty perches from the Lancaster County Shore, in Little Britain Township, Lancaster County. Containing fifteen perches of land. Surveyed the 26th day of November 1803, for Vincent ⁺Subbs by Warrant dated the 14th day of September 1803, taken from Henry Ream's filld notes, formerly deputy Surveyor. March 28th 1814.
