



A Draught of a Island Situate in the river Susquehanna called Water Willow Island about thirty perches west of Williamsons Island and about forty perches off Lancaster County Shore in Little Britain Township, in the County of Lancaster.

Containing Seventy three perches of land Surveyed the 26<sup>th</sup> of November A. D. 1803, by Henry Ream, former deputy Surveyor of Lancaster County for Vincent Stubbs by Warrant dated the 14<sup>th</sup> of September A. D. 1803, taken from his field notes remaining in my office the 28<sup>th</sup> of March 1814.
