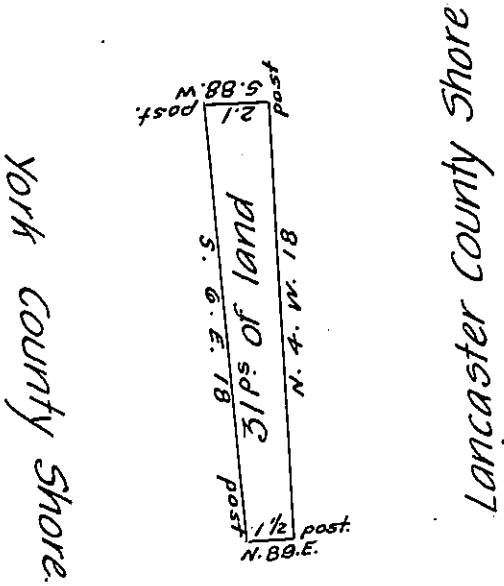

A Draught of an Island Situate in the river Susquehanna Called Southermost Island about twenty perches below Ceder Island and Water Willow Island and about thirty perches from Williamsons Island and about fifty perches from Lancaster County Shore, in Little Britain Township, in the County of Lancaster, containing thirty one perches of land. Surveyed the 26th day of November 1803, by Henry Ream then deputy Surveyor, for Vincent Stubbs by Virtue of a Warrant dated the 7th of September 1803, taken from his field notes the 28th of March 1814, remaining in my office.
