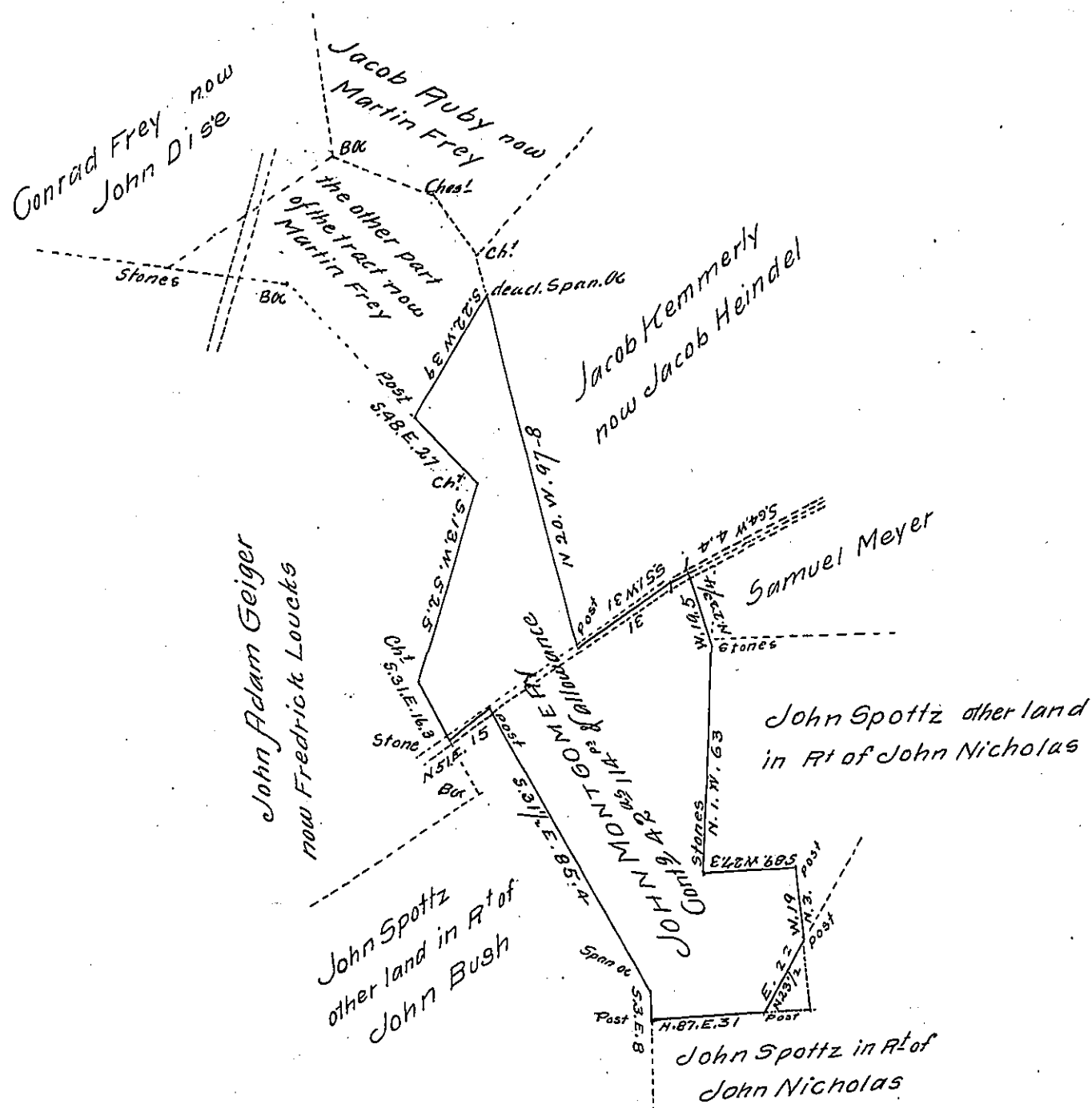

On the 7<sup>th</sup> day of April A.D. 1837 the above was Resurveyed by John Becker and now on the 7<sup>th</sup> day of August A.D. 1837 being requested to make Return of the above at the request of John Spottz the present owner &c. who wishes to Patent the same &c.
