Situate in Armagh Township formerly Cyberland County now Mifflin County part of a larger tract of Land which appears Surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant to James Sterrett dated the 4<sup>th</sup> day of Feb<sup>r</sup> 1755. Resurveyed 29<sup>th</sup> of May 1772<sup>nd</sup> by W<sup>m</sup> Maclay D.S. agreeable to the old lines. Resurveyed and divided the 20<sup>th</sup> & 21<sup>st</sup> of Dec<sup>r</sup> 1832 by D. Hough D.S. and appears to Contain as above represented — for Mrs. Rebecca Sterrett.
