



Situate in Huntingdon, now Water township Huntingdon County containing twenty four acres. Eighty eight perches with the usual allowance. Surveyed by Francis Cassidy Esqr. D.S. May 2nd 1837 in pursuance of a warrant for one hundred acres granted to Martin Ticherhoof the 5th day of Sept. 1794.
