



A Draught of a tract of land situate in Peters Township, Franklin County containing in the whole three hundred and thirty acres one hundred and fifty two perches and an allowance of six per cent for roads.

No. 1, being a tract which was surveyed in pursuance of an application granted Nathaniel M<sup>c</sup> Dowell for 150 acs. dated 1st August 1766, No. 592. &

No. 2, being a tract which was surveyed on an application granted to John M<sup>c</sup> Dowell Jun<sup>r</sup> for 200 acres dated 7th April 1767, No. 3356.

Resurveyed 9th February 1839 for the Bank of Chambersburg and Dr. Maxwell M<sup>c</sup> Dowell.
