



Situate on the waters of Stony Creek including a Dear Lick now in Stony Creek Township Somerset County (formerly Quernahoning Township Bedford County) and surveyed the 28th day of April 1797 by Alexander McClean Esqr. late deputy Surveyor as appears by his official Draught remaining in my office in pursuance of a Warrant granted unto John Rhoads dated the 13th day December 1793. And certified the 30th day of January 1810.
