



This is a draft of the east part of an undrawn tract of land No. 1943 in the Second district. Surveyed for Michael Ryhel the 13th day of July 1831. Bounded as above containing one hundred and twenty one acres and allowance. The whole tract was surveyed in 1824. Survey returned to the Office for Henry Ryhel, Father of the present owners, who was on the tract when the Law authorising the Sale of undrawn tracts was passed. Surveyed according to the original lines and corners on the ground.
