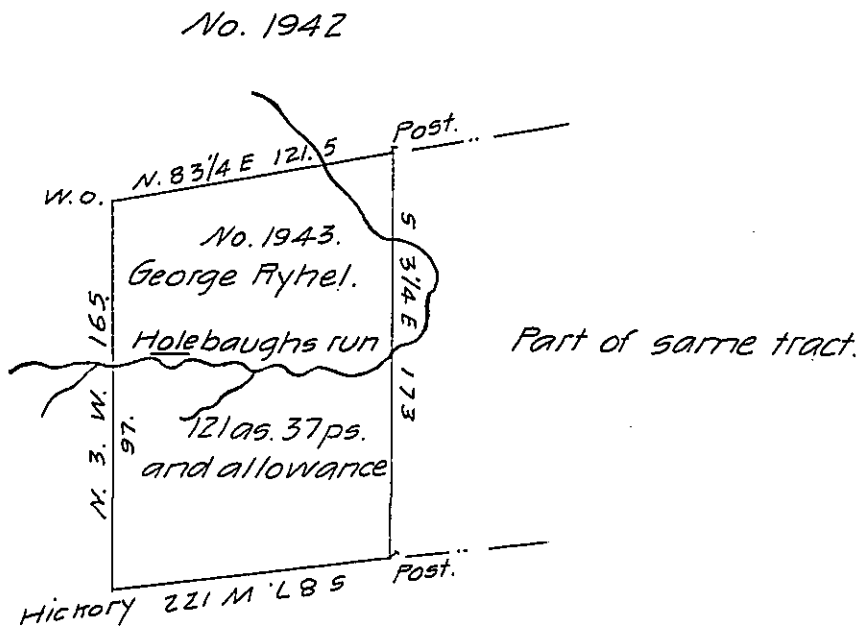

This is a draft of the western half of Donation Lott No. 1943. Situate in Slipperyrock Township, Mercer County in the Second district of Donation land. Surveyed the 13th day of July 1831, for George Fyhel Containing one hundred and twenty one acres 37 perches and the usual allowance for roads & c. The whole tract was surveyed in 1824. Survey returned to the office. Bounded as above.
