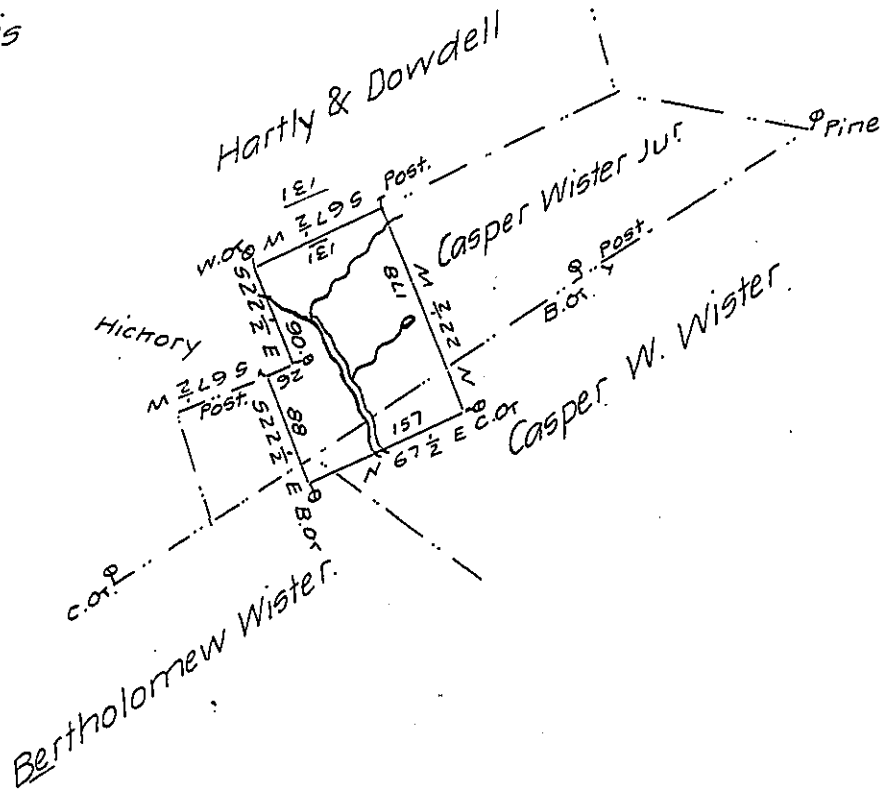

Cent &c.
