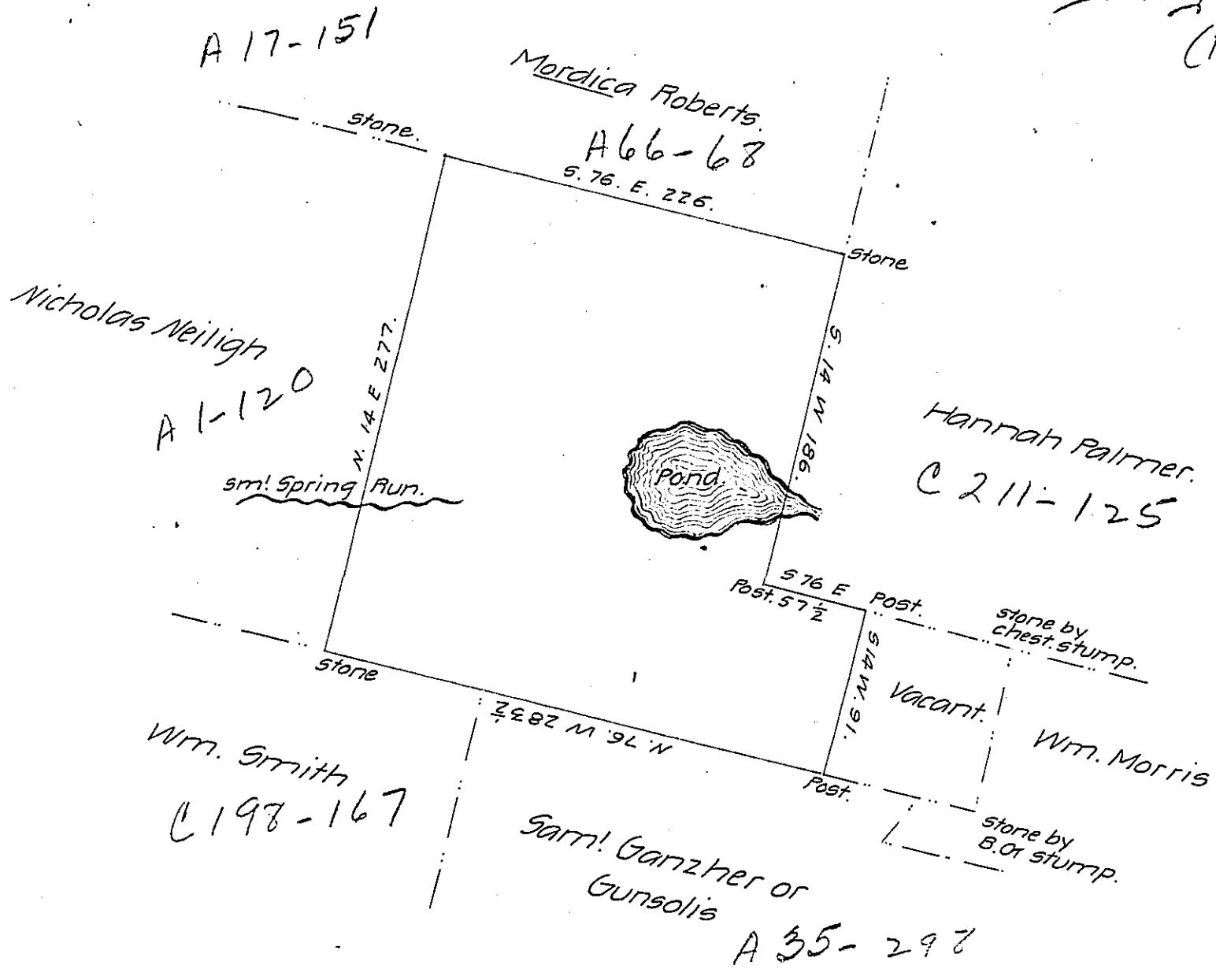

By Virtue of a Warrant dated the 20th day of December 1792
 granted to Mordica Roberts and order of Survey received Augst 12th 1843.
 Surveyed December 6th 1843 the above described Tract of Land situate
 adjoining lands granted to Hannah Palmer and extending to lands
 granted to Nicholas Neiligh including the little pond ^{Branches of Raymond's Hill} in Dingman
 Township (formerly Northampton) now Pike County containing four
 hundred acres and two perches and allowance of six pr. Ct. for
 roads &c. Pr.
