



By Virtue of a Warrant dated the thirty first day of January 1793 Surveyed the 13th day of November 1843, to Samuel Rutter the above described Tract of Land Situate on Saw Mill Creek and adjoining land (formerly known as land of Jasper Edwards) now Elijah Doolittle and Vacant Land (formerly in Uppersmithfield Township, Northampton County) now Dingman & Milford Townships, Pike County, Penna. Containing three hundred Ninety one acres, forty six perches and allowance of six p:cr. for Roads &c.
