



Situate on Shade Creek in Dublin Township Huntingdon County. Containing three hundred and nine acres, twenty four perches and the usual allowance for Roads &c.

Note. The above described Tract of land was resurveyed the 31st day of December 1807, agreeably to old lines found on the ground, supposed to be the lines of a survey made in pursuance of a Warrant to James Robb dated the 7th day of July 1762, the original survey of which cannot be found. The white oaks are both old corners, and on blocking several of the lines trees it appears to be forty years since the original survey was made.
