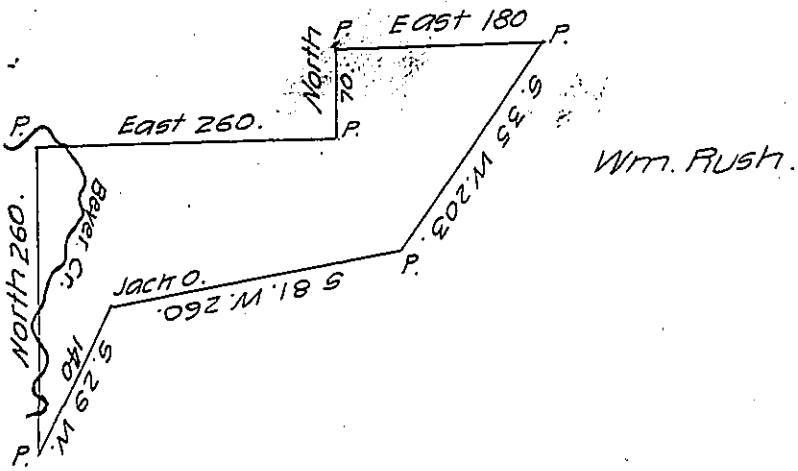

 pursuance of a Warrant granted to George Futter on the 14th day of
 April 1792. Situate Northwest of the Ohio River on the Waters of Little
 Beaver Creek adjoining land granted to William Rush called Dourlens
 containing 340 & 80 perches with the usual allowance of 6 P. Cent & c.
