



In pursuance of a warrant for 400 acres dated the 21st day of April 1794, granted to Thomas Tibbs, was surveyed on the twenty eighth day of June 1823, the above described tract of land, containing 422 acres 38 perches and allowance of six per cent for roads &c. Situate in Beaver township, Crawford county, and at the time of surveying the same Darius Larkin was residing thereon under Thomas Foster. It being the same tract which was "survey'd to Mathobl obl Clure the 4th day of March 1800 in pursuance of obl improvement bearing date the 21st January 1799"
