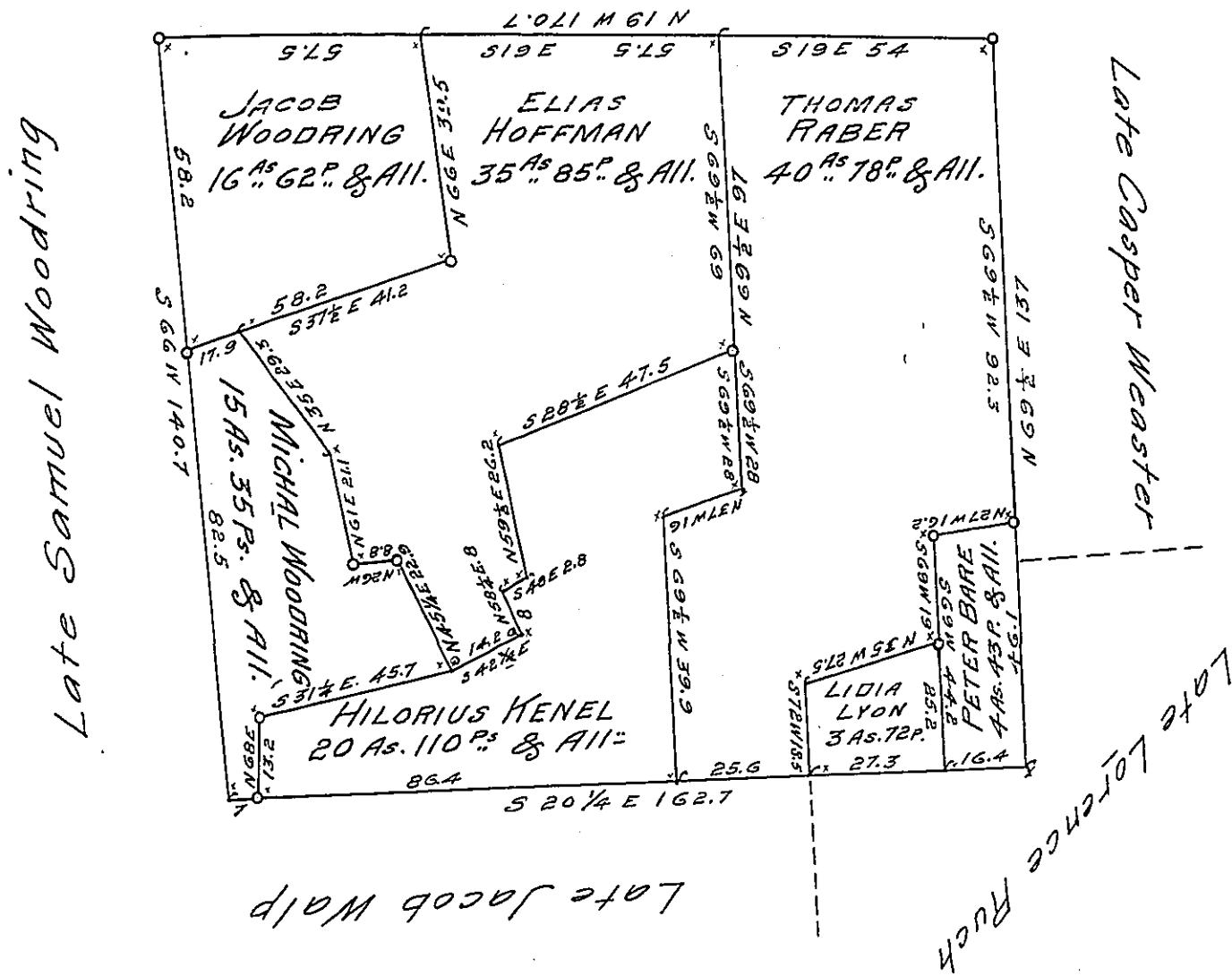


Late Martin Gross



By virtue of a warrent Dated the 8<sup>th</sup> Day of July 1741, Surveyed the 13<sup>th</sup> Day of April 1798 to Nicholas Snyder and Nicholas Sager, The Above Described Tract of Land, <sup>Now Lehigh</sup> Situated in Whitehall Township Northampton County, containing one Hundred and Forty two Acres, and one hundred and Forty Five Perches and the allowances of Six per Cent &c.

I certify that I have ReSurveyed the Above Tract of Land under the present Bearings, and Found it to contain one Hundred and Thirty Five Acres and one Hundred and Fifty one Perches, under the usual Allowences of Six Per Cent for Roads &c. Surveyed on April 25, 26 & 27 - A.D. 1866.
