



Draft of a tract of land situate in the Township of Longswamp in the County of Berks, containing One hundred and eleven acres, twenty seven perches, and the allowance of six per cent. for roads, &c., surveyed for George and Daniel Frederick the Eleventh day of June 1873 being part of a large tract of two hundred & twenty two acres — perches, and allowance, originally surveyed in pursuance of a warrant granted to John Nicholas Sneider dated the 20<sup>th</sup> day of October 1738.
