



The Draught of a tract of land called Clayland situate on the South of Juniper in the County of Cumberland. Containing five hundred fifteen acres 30 perches with the usual allowance of six acres per cent for Roads. Resurveyed (agreeable to old lines formerly run and marked) on the 9th day of December Anno Domini 1765 in pursuance of a warrant to John McClelland bearing date at Philadelphia the 8th day of September Anno Domini 1755.
