



In pursuance of an order from the Commissioners of Property dated the 16th day of June 1772 a survey was made on the 3^d day of July following of a certain lot of ground in the town of Sunbury in the County of Northumberland for Samuel Montgomery. Numbered in a General Plan of said Town one hundred and thirty five, containing in breadth East and West on the South side of Dewberry street sixty feet, and in length North and South Two hundred and thirty feet. Bounded Northward by Dewberry street a/s, Westward by Lot Number one hundred and thirty six, Southward by Mulberry Alley, and Eastward by Lot Number one hundred & thirty four. Returned into the Secretary's Office the 24th day of December, 1773, for John Montgomery Esq^r by warrant dated the 23^d December, 1773.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this nineteenth day of March 1907.
