



The above described Tract of one hundred and thirty six Acres & one hundred & forty one perches and the allowance of six per cent for Roads &c is part of a larger Tract of six hundred and nine Acres and allowance, situate, partly in Guilford & partly in Washington Townships, Franklin County, (formerly Antrim Township Cumberland County) which was Surveyed the 29<sup>th</sup> of December 1768, in pursuance of a Warrant Granted to Jacob Snively bearing date the 20<sup>th</sup> day of February 1754. Resurveyed and laid off for Charles Nill the 19<sup>th</sup> of November 1822.
