



Situate in Franklin late Managhan Township in the County of York containing as above set forth eighty six acres, seventy nine perches and allowance of six per cent for roads &c. Being part of a larger tract of 92 a's 83 p's & allowance originally surveyed by direction of Charles Lukens Esq^r late D.S. on the 16th day of March A.D. 1770 in pursuance of a Warrant for 100 a's granted to William Squib, dated the 9th day of April A.D. 1751. The above part resurveyed and divided off from the said larger tract on the 26th day of February 1822 for John Eighinger the present owner of said part, at whose request the same is returned for confirmation.
