



The above is a draught of a tract of land situate on the waters of Brush run in Peters township Washington county. Surveyed in pursuance of a warrant dated the 8th of September 1785, granted Hugh Scott and Margaret Matthews (in trust) of the Estate of James Matthews (not George Matthews as mentioned in the warrant) by Matthew Ritchie Esq^r formerly Deputy surveyor of this county, March 7th 1787, and resurveyed on the same warrant August 11th 1818 - Containing one hundred and forty six acres and one hundred and fifty four perches & the usual Allowance. The above described tract has been well improved for many years and I believe there is no adverse claim whatever against it.
