Surveyed for Robert and Nathaniel Bearley the 12<sup>th</sup> day of May 1870. It being parts of a larger tract of fifty five acres and fifty nine Perches and the Allowance &c. Originally Surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Patrick H. Turney Dated the 23<sup>d</sup> of March 1818.
