



Pursuant to a warrant granted to Andreas Tutzemberier bearing date the 3^d day of January 1733, the above described tract of land was surveyed the 19th A. mo. 1775 for his son the above named Jacob Tutzemberier situate in Strasburg township & on a Branch of Beaver Creek in Lancaster County containing 196 ¹/₄ Acres & the allowance of six per cent.
