



The outside lines of the above Draft represent a Survey made 21st June 1796 for Andrew Sniveley on his Warrant Dated 14th May 1794 situate in Antrim Township in the County of Franklin, and after the same was returned, the said Sniveley, has shewn me an Order of the Board of Property, Dated 3^d November 1794, directing me to execute said Warrant so as to leave out a small clearing belonging to Samuel Smith, the opposite Claimant, this is done & represented by the above Draft, exclusive of the dotted lines, which said lines include the said Clearing at the hand, the contents of which amounts to one perch & two tenths, & the remainder left for Sniveley's Warrant, agreeable to said Order of the Honorable Board, amounts to thirteen Acres 100 Perches & the proportional Allowance of Six $\frac{1}{2}$ Cent &c resurveyed 11th September 1800.
