



In pursuance of a Warrant for 400⁰⁰ of Land granted to Edward Tighman dated 14th day of April A.D. 1792 was surveyed on the 25th day of December 1829 the above described tract of land containing three hundred sixty one acres one hundred thirty nine perches and allowance of six percent for Roads &c. and Charles Ridgway was living on the same & there appeared to be upwards of thirty acres of the Land under cultivation Situate in Oil Creek Township Crawford County Pennsylvania
