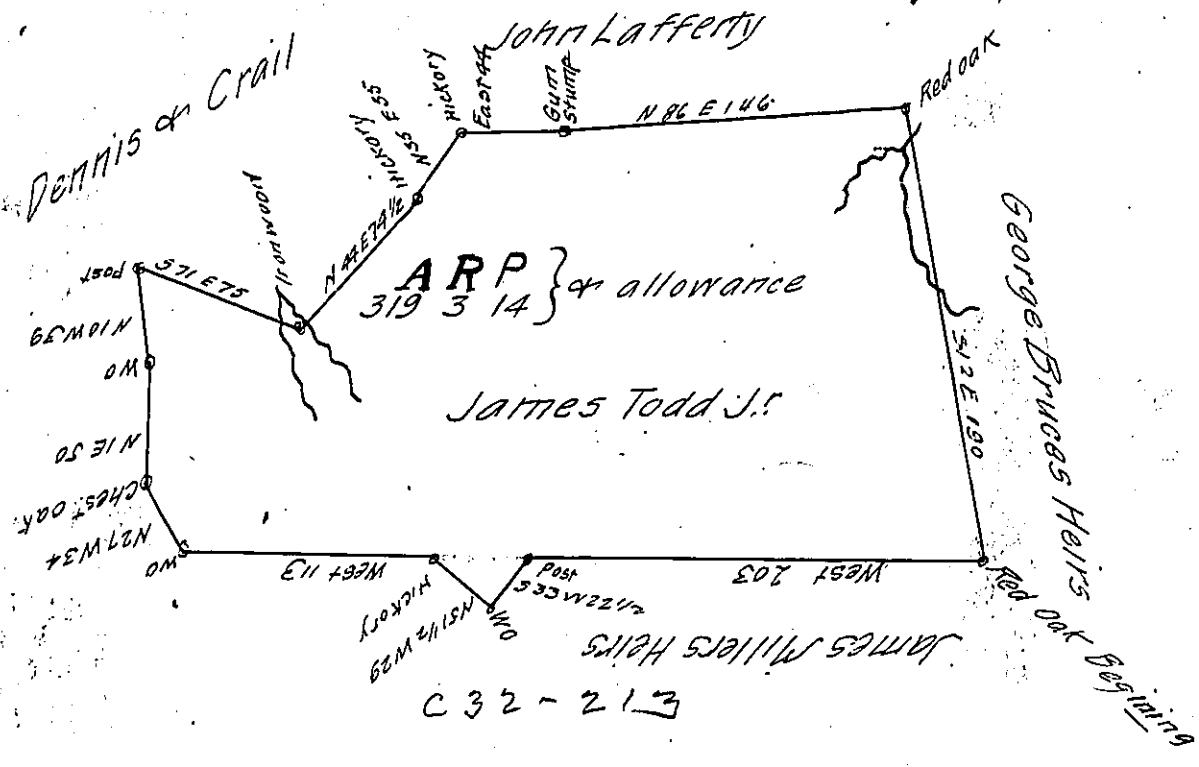

The above is a Draught of a Resurvey made the 9th day of June 1828 for James Todd Junior in pursuance of a Warrent dated 26th December 1821 Situated in Moon Township in Beaver County containing three hundred nineteen Acres three quarters fourteen perches and allowance of six per Cent for roads &c.

Note I know not whether ornot I have done right to make this resurvey with out your particular directions but James Todd requested me to make it and you will see by Comparing the above Draught with the Draught of the survey formerly made on the same Warrent that there is no material difference except on the southern Boundary where you will see that the former survey took in more Land than the one above This Land which is now left out of the last survey is property of the Heirs of James Miller dec^d and Mr. Todd requested that it might be left out that he might get a correct pattent for his Land
