



Situate in Newberg township in the County of York containing as above set forth Ninety five acres and three perches and the usual allowance of six feet for roads 46' Being part of a larger tract of 144^{ac} 64^{ac} and allowance of land originally surveyed by William Matthews late D.S. on the 20th day of the 9th Mo 1764 in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Joseph Taylor for 100^{ac} dated the 4th day of August 1762.

The above part resurveyed and divided off from the said larger tract on the 6th day of March 1822 for Abraham Miller the present owner of the said part at whose request the same is returned for confirmation
